
FOREWORD

Computerization of College Administration is extended by purchasing computers. Office work is computerized and Internet facilities are provided to all the departments and library and office, etc.

Increasing infrastructure:

All the science laboratories are well equipped with museums specimens, instruments, equipments, chemicals, etc. and all the science departments were provided with independent computers and some of science departments like zoology, which is actively involved in M.Phil, and Ph.D. research activities and under the guidance of Dr.V.B.Chimkod 12 M.Phil. Scholars have completed their M.Phil, and at present 6 Ph.D. scholars are working.

Teaching aids like' OHP, LCD and slide projector were provided to all the science departments for conducting regular students seminar classes, etc.

Our college garden is well maintained to have a good academic atmosphere in the college.

Technology Upgradation and Computer Centre:

As part of technology upgradation few new computers have been made available in the college and a separate computer room is established as a computer centre, by this our college students and staff are regularly use computers and regular computer classes are conducted for commerce students.
